### Social Disorder

- 157 calls for service for narcotics since 2000, with a peak in 2001;
- Total of 17 911 calls for shootings since 2000;
- Concentration of juvenile arrests in 2004

### Surrounding Context

- Residential properties;
- Stores and salon on corners

### Routine Opportunity Areas

- Foot traffic to/from shops;
- Parallel parked cars

### Physical Disorder

- Chronically vacant properties on the west side of the 400 block of N. Milton Avenue

### Built Environment & Design

- Wide, pedestrian-friendly sidewalks;
- Adequate lighting

### Streets and Alleys

- Orleans Street is a high-traffic, two way street;
- Milton Avenue is a residential, two-way moderate traffic street

### Sense of Community

- 50/50 mix of owner- and renter-occupied properties on the residential corners of the intersection
