### Social Disorder

- 68 calls for service for narcotics since 2000, with peaks in 2006;
- Total of three 911 calls for shootings since 2000);
- Concentrations of juvenile arrests in 2000 and 2009

### Surrounding Context

- William Paca Elementary School;
- Residential area;
- Traffic island and open green space

### Routine Opportunity Areas

- Parallel parked cars;
- Moderate foot-traffic area

### Physical Disorder

- Some vacant properties on the east side of the 200 block of N. Lakewood Avenue

### Built Environment & Design

- Five-way intersection;
- Wide sidewalks for foot traffic;
- Open green space between Pulaski Highway and Fayette Street

### Streets and Alleys

- Milton Street is a residential, two-way, moderate traffic street;
- Orleans/Fayette Alley is narrow and provides a shortcut to N/S running alleys

### Sense of Community

- High rate of renter-occupied properties on the residential corners of the intersection
