Social Disorder

- 144 calls for service for narcotics since 2000, with peaks in 2003, 2005, 2009;
- Total of three 911 calls for shootings since 2000;
- Concentrations of juvenile arrests in 2002, 2003, 2006, 2007 (predominantly drug-related), and 2009

Surrounding Context

- Enoch Pratt Free Library;
- Church;
- Residential area south of Fayette Street

Routine Opportunity Areas

- High daytime population at library

Physical Disorder

- Some vacant properties on the 200 block of N. Linwood Avenue;
- High concentration of 311 CitiStat calls for service for trash at intersection

Built Environment & Design

- Wide sidewalks for foot traffic;
- Adequate lighting across from library, in front of church

Streets and Alleys

- Fayette Street is a high traffic, mixed use, two-way street with bus traffic;
- Pulaski Highway is a moderate traffic, one-way street;
- Linwood Avenue is a moderate traffic street, with one way traffic south to Pulaski Highway

Sense of Community

- High rates of owner-occupancy on Linwood, south of the hotspot at Fayette Street
