- 17 calls for service for narcotics since 2000, with a peak year in 2008;
- Total of one 911 call for shootings since 2000;
- Concentrations of juvenile arrests for drug-related offenses in 2001 and 2003

- Commercial intersection;
- Mix of businesses (Takeout food, grocery store)

Routine Opportunity Areas

- High daytime population with foot traffic

Physical Disorder

- Low rates of 311 CitiStat calls for service for trash

Built Environment & Design

- Adequate street lighting

Streets and Alleys

- Monument Street a major eastbound traffic corridor with bus traffic (#35);
- Milton/Rose Alley is narrow and predominantly pedestrian traffic and terminates at Monument Street

Sense of Community

- Commercial street with some renter-occupied properties north of Monument Street
