Social Disorder

- 364 calls for service for narcotics since 2000, particularly in 2000-2005 and 2011;
- Total of seven 911 calls for shootings since 2000;
- No significant juvenile crime in hotspot (2000-2011)

Surrounding Context

- Residential properties;
- Corner grocery store

Routine Opportunity Areas

- Loitering around corner store;
- Parallel parked cars with little to no street lighting;
- Bus stop on SE corner of intersection (#13)

Physical Disorder

- Chronically vacant properties on the 800 block of N. Kenwood Avenue;
- High rate of 311 CitiStat calls for service for trash in 2007 and 2010

Built Environment & Design

- Possibly inadequate lighting at night;
- Wide sidewalks for easy foot traffic

Streets and Alleys

- Kenwood Avenue and McElderry Street are residential, moderate width streets;
- McElderry Street has bus traffic

Sense of Community

- 50/50 mix of owner- and renter-occupied properties on the residential corners of the intersection
