



Children and Family Health and Well-Being

Baltimore City has made improving the lives of its residents, both young and old, a priority. BNIA-JFI tracks several indicators that are designed to monitor the health and well-being of City's residents and their neighborhoods. A summary of these indicators and their change over the past several years is described below.

Safe Homes and Families

• The percentage of children who were tested for the presence of lead in their blood and were found to have elevated blood lead levels decreased by 1.7%. In 2008, the CSAs where the greatest percentages of tested children had elevated levels of lead in their blood included Madison/East End, Clifton-Berea, and Upton/Druid Heights.

Income and Poverty

• From 2003 to 2008, the median household income of Baltimore City residents increased by 24.2% from \$32,452 in 2003 to \$40,313 in 2008.

Maternal and Child Health

- Both the percentage of births delivered at term (85.4% in 2003 to 86.3% in 2008) and babies born with satisfactory birth weight (86.3% in 2003 to 87.2% in 2008) in Baltimore City increased slightly.
- The percentage of births where the mother received early prenatal care decreased slightly from 74.9% in 2003 to 73.7% in 2008.
- In 2008, Clifton-Berea had the lowest percentage of mothers receiving early prenatal care at 60.3%. Canton had the highest rate with 89.8% of mothers receiving early prenatal care.
- The teen birth rate in Baltimore City declined slightly from 68.2 per 1,000 teens giving birth in 2003 to 66.1 in 2008. In nine CSAs, at least one in ten teens gave birth in 2008. These CSAs include: Madison/East End, Brooklyn/Curtis Bay/Hawkins Point, Fells

Point, Southwest Baltimore, Clifton-Berea, Sandtown-Winchester/Harlem Park, Greater Rosemont, Downtown/Seton Hill, and Westport/Mount Winans/Lakeland.

Access to Health Insurance and Preventative Health Care

- The percentage of persons with vaccine preventable diseases declined from 2003 to 2008, but increased from 2007 to 2008. A possible explanation may be that as the economy worsened, a greater number of City residents might not have sought preventable heath care treatments, such as receiving vaccines, in an effort to reduce their household expenses.
- From 2003 to 2008, the percentage of emergency room visits by City residents that were not for emergency reasons increased from 3.6% to 7.8%. This could indicate that emergency rooms were being used to diagnose and treat medical conditions that might otherwise have been addressed by regular doctor and preventative health care visits.

Drug Treatment

• The number of Baltimore City residents receiving drug treatment services increased by 45.2% from 2003 to 2008 with over 23,000 City residents receiving treatment in 2008.
