

Neighborhood Action and Sense of Community

Baltimore City has a rich history of community organizing and involvement. BNIA-JFI tracks several neighborhood and community indicators to measure the extent in which the City's neighborhoods are active, organized, and empowered. Highlights of changes in the neighborhood action and sense of community indicators tracked by BNIA-JFI include:

Neighborhood Groups

- In 2008, the City reported nearly 500 neighborhood associations and block clubs. This number has decreased since 2003 when there were 650 neighborhood associations and block clubs. It is hard to determine the cause of this decrease, but it may be due to less engaged residents and/or groups not registering their information with the City Department of Planning that maintains the list of community groups in Baltimore City.
- The number of Community Development Corporations (CDCs) increased from 45 in 2003 to 60 in 2008. CDCs provide important and wide-ranging programs, services, and other activities that promote and support community but are primarily engaged in housing development.

Neighborhood Initiatives

- The number of neighborhoods with a Healthy Neighborhood Initiative program (HNI) has nearly doubled from 10 in 2006 to 19 in 2008. The mission of HNI is to help strong but undervalued City neighborhoods increase home values, market their community, create high standards for property improvements, and forge strong connections among neighbors.
- The number of registered historic buildings has increased by 19% from 2003 to 2008. As of 2008, there are over 8,600 designated historic buildings in Baltimore City with the largest numbers of these buildings located in Midtown and Fells Point.

Voter Participation

• The percentage of the City's residents who are registered to vote increased from 59.0% in 2002 to 67.0% in 2008.

• The percentage of the City's residents who voted in the general election increased by 18.1% percentage points from 32.6% in 2002 to 50.7% in 2008. An increasing level of voter turnout may be an indicator that residents are becoming more involved in community and in civic decisions that may impact their neighborhoods.
