

Census Demographics

The United States Bureau of the Census collects a wide variety of social, demographic, and housing information on both persons and households across the United States. The Bureau of the Census administers both a decennial Census and the American Community Survey (ACS). While the decennial Census and the ACS are not directly comparable, by looking at the change from 2000 to 2009, it can provide a glimpse of how Baltimore City has changed over time. BNIA-JFI analyzed data from the Census as a means to both provide greater understanding as to the socioeconomic and demographic characteristics of the residents of the City and its neighborhoods. BNIA-JFI also used this data as denominators for many of the Vital Signs indicators allowing for data to be normalized and rates to be computed. Census data analyzed by BNIA-JFI is grouped into the following categories: population, race and ethnicity; households and families; and income. Highlights of the data from 2009 are provided below.

Population, Race and Ethnicity

- From 2000 to 2009, Baltimore City's population has declined by 2.1%, decreasing from 651,154 to 637,418 persons.
- From 2008 to 2009, the City's population has increased slightly (by less than 500 residents).
- African American residents in Baltimore City outnumber residents of all other races by nearly 2:1. The percentage of the City's population that is African American decreased from 64.0% in 2000 to 62.2% in 2009, while the percentage of white residents has increased slightly from 31.0% to 32.4% and the percentage of Hispanic residents increased from 1.7% to 3.0%.

Households and Families

- The number of households in Baltimore City declined by 9.0% from 257,996 in 2000 to 234,840 in 2009.
- The average household size in Baltimore City increased slightly from 2.4 persons per household in 2000 to 2.6 persons per household in 2009.

Income

- The largest percentage of households either earn less than \$25,000 per year (34.2% in 2009) or earn more than \$75,000 per year (22.7%).
- The percentage of households earning less than \$25,000 per year has decreased from 42.8% in 2000 to 34.2% in 2009 and the households earning over \$75,000 per year has increased from 12.9% in 2000 to 22.7% in 2009. The percentage of households earning from \$25,000 to \$75,000 per year has held fairly steady from 2000 to 2009.
