


Crime & Safety

Over the past decade, Baltimore City has made improving the safety of its residents and visitors a priority. While incidents of crime and criminal activity tend to dominate the news, in reality many of the City's neighborhoods have become increasingly safer over the past several years. BNIA-JFI tracks two measures of adult crime, Part 1 crimes and violent crimes. Part 1 offenses, include homicide, rape, aggravated assault, robbery, burglary, larceny, and auto theft. Violent crimes are a subset of Part 1 offenses and include homicide, rape, aggravated assault, and robbery. These more violent offenses tend to be covered by the news and are an important indicator as to the physical safety of residents.

From 2000 to 2010, the Part 1 crime rate and violent crime rate both declined. Specifically, the number of

reported Part 1 crime incidents has decreased by over 45% and violent crime incidents has decreased by 11% from 2000 to 2010. Despite the long-term decreases in the Part 1 crime rate and the violent crime rate, Baltimore City experienced a slight increase in both rates from 2009 to 2010.



Rates of domestic violence are also an important indicator of the safety and well-being of a community's residents. Similar to both the Part 1 and violent crime rates, the rate of 911 calls for service decreased over the decade, but increased from 2009 to 2010.

All crime data for Vital Signs indicators are provided by the Baltimore City Police Department. BNIA-JFI normalizes this data by population to establish crime rates. Normalizing data allows for the rates to reflect the concentration of the crime relative to the population in the area and allows for comparison between areas of different populations. A summary of these crime and safety indicators and their change over the past several years is described below.


Vital Signs 10 Crime

¹ The FBI Uniform Crime Report definition of Part 1 crime also includes arson, but for the purposes of this analysis it has been excluded.

In 2010, BNIA-JFI was only able to analyze three indicators designed to track adult crime and safety in Baltimore City and its neighborhoods. Unfortunately, juvenile arrest indicators previously tracked by BNIA-JFI were currently unavailable for 2010. While some information was available from the Baltimore City Police Department, the information available did not allow for the arrest information to be analyzed by neighborhood. The Baltimore City Police Department is working to address this issue and BNIA-JFI hopes to be able to analyze this information and provide our juvenile arrest indicators at a later point.

Part 1 Crime

- The Part 1 crime rate in Baltimore City has declined from 106.0 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2000 to 61.4 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2010.
- The CSAs that have experienced the greatest decreases in Part 1 crime in the past decade have been Downtown/Seton Hill, Midtown, and Fells Point.
- From 2000 to 2010, no CSA experienced an increase in their Part 1 crime rate.
- The Part 1 crime rate in Baltimore City increased by nearly two incidents per 1,000 persons from 59.6 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2009 to 61.4 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2010.
- The CSAs that experienced the greatest increase in Part 1 crime from 2009 to 2010 include Inner Harbor/Federal Hill, Southwest Baltimore, and Greater Mondawmin.




The CSAs with the highest overall crime rates in 2010 were Downtown/Seton Hill (424.4 offenses per 1,000 persons), Inner Harbor/Federal Hill (165.2 offenses per 1,000 persons), Washington Village (123.9 offenses per 1,000 persons), Harbor East/Little Italy (119.3 offenses per 1,000 persons), and Greater Mondawmin (112.4 offenses per 1,000 persons). A possible explanation of these high rates may be that these are destination areas that attract a large number of employees and tourists, whereas the number of crimes is normalized by the resident population which is relatively low compared to the total number of additional employees and tourists that come there.

Violent Crime

- The City's violent crime rate decreased by nearly 11 incidents per 1,000 persons from 26.2 violent offenses per 1,000 persons in 2000 to 15.6 violent offenses per 1,000 persons in 2010.
- The greatest decreases in the violent crime rate in the past decade include Downtown/Seton Hill, Patterson Park North and East, and Southeastern.
- Only one CSA (Harford/Echodale) experienced an increase in their violent crime rate from 2000 to 2010.
- From 2009 to 2010, the violent crime rate for the City as a whole increased slightly from 15.3 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2009 to 15.6 offenses per 1,000 persons in 2010.
- The CSAs that experienced the greatest increase in violent crime from 2009 to 2010 include

Pimlico/Arlington/Hilltop, Downtown/Seton Hill, and Inner Harbor/Federal Hill.

■ The CSAs with the highest overall violent rates in 2010 were Downtown/Seton Hill (97.9 offenses per 1,000 persons), Southwest Baltimore (28.8 offenses per 1,000 persons), Harbor East/Little Italy (28.5 offenses per 1,000 persons), Oldtown/Middle East (27.8 offenses per 1,000 persons), Upton/Druid Heights (27.3 offenses per 1,000 persons), and Sandtown-Winchester/Harlem Park (27.1 offenses per 1,000 persons).

Domestic Violence

- From 2000 to 2010, the domestic violence rate has decreased by 6.6 incidents per 1,000 persons.
- Since 2007, the domestic violence rate has been steadily increasing from 28.9 incidents per 1,000 persons in 2007 to 50.5 incidents per 1,000 persons in 2010.
- From 2000 to 2010, the greatest percentage decreases in calls of domestic violence were in Madison/East End and South Baltimore.
- From 2000 to 2010, the greatest percentage increases in 911 calls for domestic violence were reported in Mount Washington/Coldspring, Inner Harbor/Federal Hill, and Greater Roland Park/Poplar Hill.
- In 2010, the number of 911 calls reporting incidences of domestic violence was 50.5 incidents per 1,000 persons. This is an increase of nearly 3 calls per 1,000 persons or 5.6% from 2009.

- In 2010, the CSAs with the lowest domestic violence rate were South Baltimore (19.4 incidents per 1,000 persons), Cross Country/Cheswolde (22.6 incidents per 1,000 persons), and Midtown (25.0 incidents per 1,000 persons).
- In 2010, the CSAs with the highest domestic violence rate were Downtown/Seton Hill (91.9 incidents per 1,000 persons), Washington Village (83.0 incidents per 1,000 persons), and Harbor East/Little Italy (74.9 incidents per 1,000 persons).
